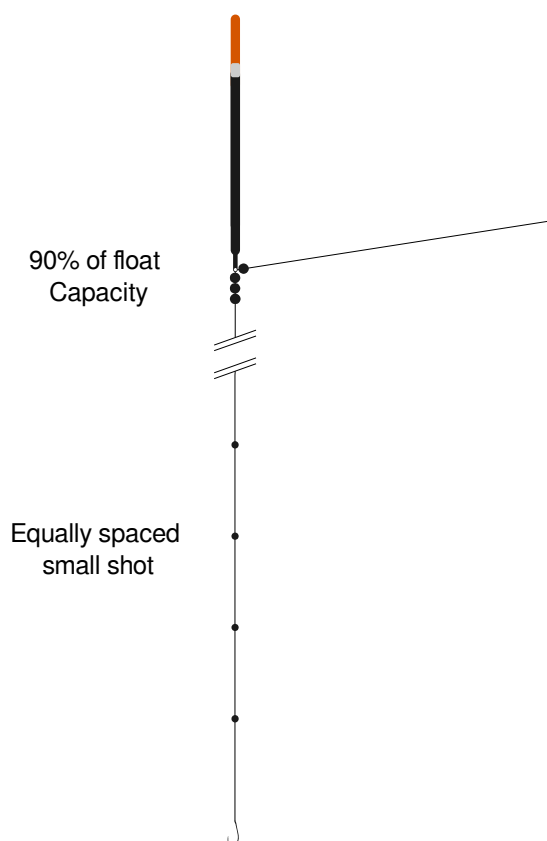
Waggler float shotted patterns

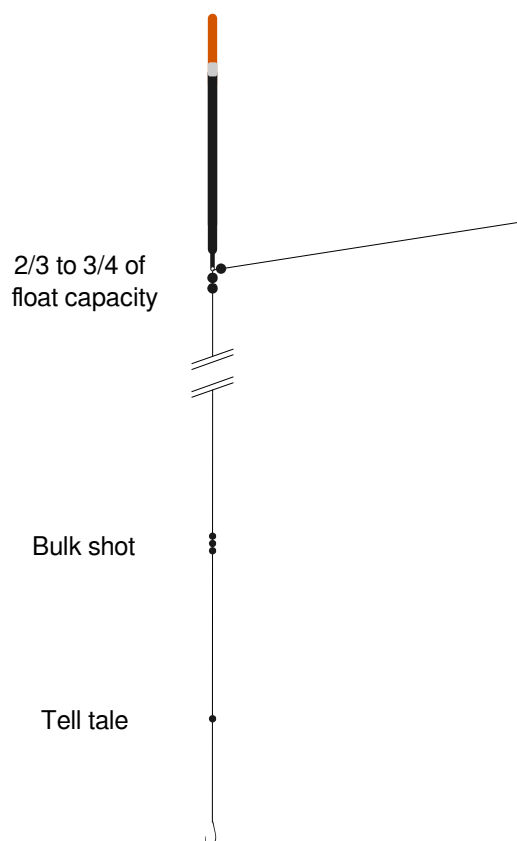
Description

Straight waggler - a buoyant float used on ponds and rivers which can be fished on the drop and on the bottom.

Slow sinking mid water rig



Fast sinking bottom rig



Additional

Fixed bottom end only - common to all wagglers

Pond & river

Shot bulked around the base

Slow sinking - equally spaced small shot down the line to catch on the drop

Fast sinking - bulk shot used to quickly sink bait to catch on the bottom

Bite indication - lift or submerge

Amount of float top above the surface effects sensitivity
